BOARDING 10:00AM

You should have your group lined up at the dock no later than 10:00am

DEPARTURE 10:30AM

The GOODTIME III leaves the Pier promptly at 10:30am

RETURN 12:30PM

RESERVATIONS:

Reservations must be made by calling (216) 861-5110. Please have at least two dates in mind when you call. We will need the number of students, teachers and chaperones. The e-mail, mailing address and telephone number of the school are also necessary for confirmation. Due to availability and varying time schedules, we find most schools book tours well in advance. With this in mind, we suggest that you book your class ASAP to get the date of your choice. Final Counts are due two weeks prior to sailing date.

FEES:

The student fare is \$8.00 each. One teacher is free per 25 paying students. **Adult Chaperones are \$10.00 each.** Children accompanying parent/chaperones will pay the student rate. We prefer one person from your school report to the ticket office to check in, pay and sign for the Boarding Pass. **Adult Chaperones pay the regular Adult rate of \$17.00 if paying separately from the School.**

LUNCHES:

A BROWN BAG SACK Lunch is available at \$5.75+tax per person. This must be pre-ordered and paid for two weeks in advance. Students may also bring their own bag lunches (**NO GLASS BEVERAGE CONTAINERS ARE PERMITTED**). A Snack Bar is also open for cash purchase of sandwiches, snacks and soft drinks.

PAYMENT INFO:

Payment is due **BEFORE BOARDING** on the day of the cruise.

FORMS OF PAYMENT: School Check, Completed School Purchase Order, Bank Check, Money Order and Credit card accepted. (**Sorry, No Personal Checks**)

If School pays with a Purchase Order – we MUST receive a copy of it in advance of the cruise date.

RULES & REGULATIONS

Teacher must report to Ticket Office to take care of payments and obtain a Boarding Pass in order to board GOODTIME III. **Safety is PARAMOUNT;** Students MUST be supervised the entire time they are aboard the ship. No running or horseplay is permitted. Teachers and chaperones are responsible for the behavior and safety of their students. Students are expected to be kept seated and quiet during the narration (as they would in a classroom). The route may vary at the Captain's discretion, due to unforeseen river traffic and/or weather conditions.

PARKING:

School Busses should park at the Port Authority Lot, a 10 minute walk from the dock; there is a nominal \$10.00 charge for school bus parking, \$1.00 for autos. Instruct the Bus Driver to drop off the students at the cul-de-sac at the foot of East 9th Street. The Bus Driver should then proceed south on E. 9th Street to first Stop Sign **Eriesside Ave** turn RIGHT. Then turn RIGHT at the first Stop Sign and go straight into the Port Authority Lot. Please plan ahead if the bus driver is taking the cruise - the Port Lot is a 10-minute walk from the GOODTIME III Dock and boarding ramp.

Cars can park on the Pier on a first-come, first serve basis. The Pier lot is **NEW** and is \$8.00 per car. Parking rates are subject to change and Goodtime III has no control over Parking Rates. www.goodtimeiii.com
